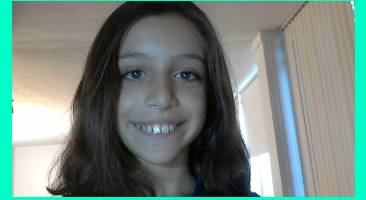

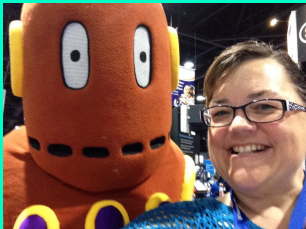

FIRST GRADE

SS.1.C.3.In.b: Recognize symbols and individuals that represent America, such as the American flag, Pledge of Allegiance, bald eagle, and current president.

SECOND GRADE

SS.2.G.1.In.b: Identify the student's city and state.

Sara- "lift-the-flap" book

Adam- Puppet show

THIRD GRADE

SS.3.E.1.In.d: Recognize forms of money used in the United States and one other country.

Sara- Create a store

Adam- Matching game

FOURTH GRADE

SS.4.A.2.In.a: Identify important cultural aspects of Native American tribes of Florida, such as living in villages and making pottery.

Sara- Weave on a loom.
